1 in 3 students struggle with feelings of isolation or disconnection.






The Problem? These are not signs of laziness or lack of discipline—they are nervous system responses indicative of people stuck in survival mode.

WHAT IS SURVIVAL MODE IN A SCHOOL CONTEXT?

Survival mode is a psychological and physiological state where the brain and body operate in fight, flight, freeze, or fawn patterns—constantly scanning for threat rather than opportunities for growth.



THERMOSTAT VS. THERMOMETER

Overview: A thermometer reacts to the temperature. A thermostat sets it. Be the thermostat—choose how you respond.

ACTIVITY #1: TRIGGER & THERMOSTAT MAPPING (10 MINS)

- What are 2 things that regularly throw you off your center at school?
- How do you usually react? (thermometer behavior)
- What could you do instead to stay grounded? (thermostat behavior)

Group share (optional): Ask students to give one example of how they plan to "set the tone" in a future moment.

ACTIVITY #2: "LEAVE THE BONES" REFLECTION (5 MINS)

Not every situation will be perfect, and not every word spoken to you will be kind or useful. Prompt: Think of a moment that didn't go how you wanted—but taught you something. What was the "fish" (the part you could learn from)? What was the "bone" (the part you left behind)?
